**C**ape Cod Massachusetts is known around the world for its beaches, geography, historic significance, fishing, whale watching and lighthouses. The Cape Cod & Islands Council has created a program for older Scouts and Venturers which will give them the chance to experience the Cape or Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard Islands. This program was created to offer a combination of challenging experiences which cannot be found anywhere else in the nation and has been selected by "Scouting" magazine as a **Cool Camp**.



### Arrival

**1:00 P.M:**

Arrive at Camp Greenough. Check in and take swim test. Complete bicycle and kayak orientation. Review trek itinerary, have gear issued, supper and camp out.

### Day 1

**7:00 AM:**

Bike from camp to Eastham. Visit Salt Pond visitors center. Set up camp at National Seashore site. Swim at Coast Guard Beach, one of the top ten beaches in the US. Supper followed by surf fishing.



### Day 2

**7:00 AM:**

Bicycle to Wellfleet Harbor. Meet with the Shellfish Warden. Help clean beds for reseeding clams and oysters. Kayak to Great Island. Lunch. Bike to Town of Truro campsite. Visit Ballston Beach.

### Day 3

**7:00 AM:**

Bicycle to Provincetown. Swim at Race Point. Bike through the Province lands dunes. Set sail and spend the night on a majestic coastal schooner. Pizza supper.





#### **Day 4**

**5:00 AM:**

**Meet lobsterman at Macmillan Wharf. Help pull pots and band lobsters. Return to Provincetown for lunch. Board "The Dolphin" for late afternoon whale watch.**

#### **Day 5**

**Bicycle to Camp Greenough. Clam Bake supper. Shower. Debrief. Next day 7:00 AM breakfast. Pack up, clean up, and depart for home.**

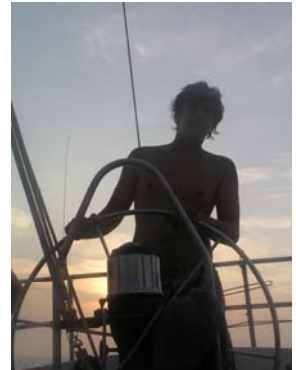

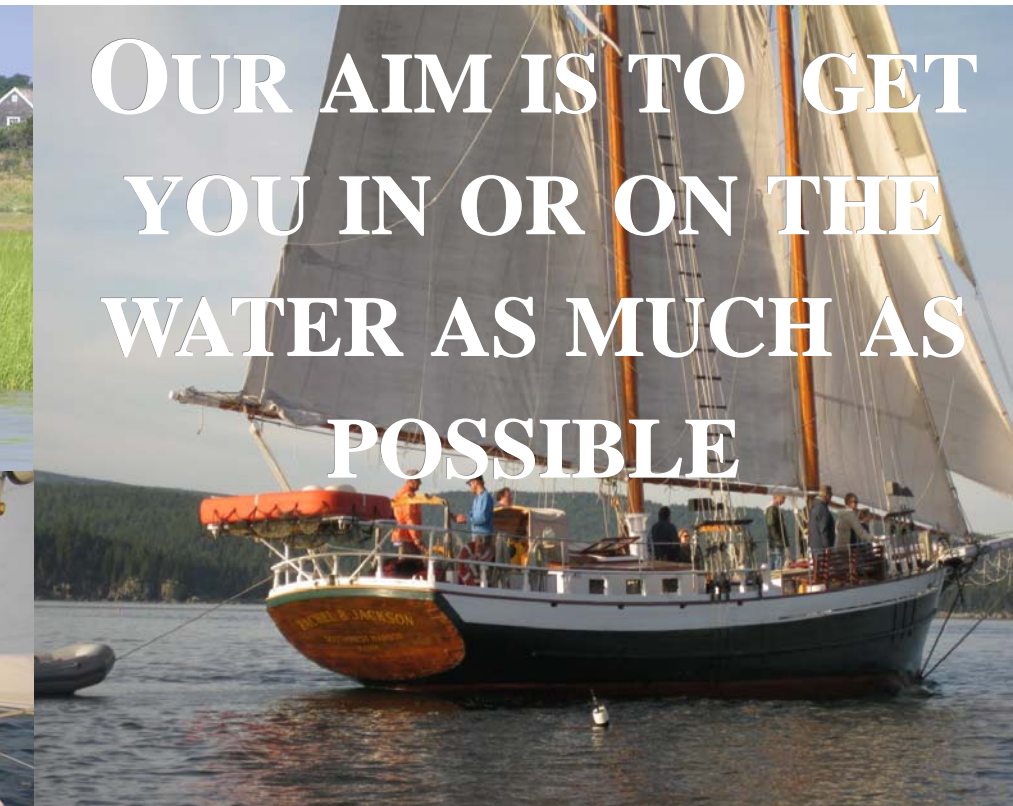

Travel by bicycle to historic Hyannis. You will then board a ferry to Martha's Vineyard and begin your island hopper adventure. After

a day and a half of exploring Martha's Vineyard you will board a ferry to the former whaling capital of the world, Nantucket, where you will spend two fun filled days exploring a true vacation paradise. Then it's back to Camp Greenough for a traditional Clam Bake of Lobster, Clams, and all the fixings.

During your stay on the Islands you will also be able to kayak, swim, go surf fishing, visit historic museums and Indian Reservations, or just relax and take in all the sights and sounds of these quaint islands. The adventure is up to you.

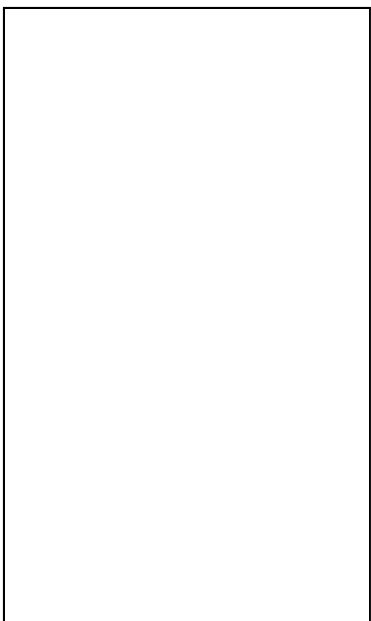
