



2017 Turkey Shoot Fact Sheet

There are separate forms for Webelos and Boy Scout/Venture registration.

Pre-registration and pre-payment by units is required. No individual registrations will be accepted. All changes to registration must be made or authorized by the leader who made the initial registration. Units whose actual numbers vary from registration are encouraged to buy or sell unused tickets from other unit leaders Friday night. This event usually sells out and on-site registration may or may not be available.

Units are encouraged to camp for the weekend. Reserve camp sites in the usual manner; through the Council Office. Site fees **are NOT included in event registration**. You may request a specific camp site but your unit may be moved to better match campsites to unit size. Troops are encouraged to contact Webelos Dens and host them for a weekend of scout camping, packs may also reserve a site or building and camp on their own.

Webelos will compete in Archery and BB Gun Shooting. Leaders need to know upon arrival how many are 4th graders and how many are 5th graders, as they will be scored separately, so more prizes can be awarded.

Scouts and Venturer/Venture-age scouts can compete in Archery, Muzzleloader, Shotgun, and Rifle Shooting at traditional ranges. Scoring is split into Junior (age 11-13) and Senior (age 14-20) Divisions. Unit leaders: please know at Friday check in how many of your scouts are in each division. **Shotgun Shooting** for Junior Division will be a “Lucky Target” plate shoot with a 20 gauge shotgun. Older scouts and Venturers (age 14 - 20) may compete in Clay Shoot at flying targets with 12 gauge shotguns.

All troops, crews, posts, and ships are asked to have a scout skill “**Show and Do**” activity for Webelos and others to participate in between events. There also may be vendors and exhibitors with the “**Show and Do’s**”, **10 am-2 pm** in and near the Pavilion. “**John’s Dog Wagon**” will once again be on site at the Dining Hall selling coffee, hot chocolate, snacks, and lunch items. Camp Trading Post will also be open at select times throughout the weekend.

All participants must take safety classes Friday evening (Webelos 6:30 pm, Scouts 7:30 pm) **OR** take the safety class at an earlier event where practice will be available.

Cub Scout BB and Archery will be part of WCAW on October 28th, with a Safety Class offered at 12:30 pm.

Rifle Shooting will be part of VESS September 15th-16th, Rifle Safety Briefing will be offered.

Rifle and Shotgun Shooting will be available at JOTA October 21st for a small fee, and both Safety Briefings will be offered.
